Instructions for Candidates

- Physical presence of the candidate at the time of counselling is compulsory. No request for online counselling or representation through any other person shall be entertained.
- Candidates are required to report at the counselling venue by 9:30 AM on 02 July 2026.
- Candidates are required to bring the following original documents along with one set of self-attested photocopies:
 - Printed copy of the Online Application Form.
 - Matriculation (10th) or equivalent certificate as proof of Date of Birth.
 - Detailed Marks Card(s)/Transcript(s) of the Senior Secondary (10+2) Examination.
 - Character Certificate issued by the Principal/Head of the Institution last attended.
 - Two recent passport-size photographs (with the candidate's name written on the reverse side).
 - Original Reservation Certificate, Punjab Residence Certificate, and Income Certificate (wherever applicable), as prescribed in the GNDU Admission Prospectus 2026-27.
- All admissions shall be provisional and subject to verification of original documents and fulfillment of the prescribed eligibility conditions. If, at any stage, any information furnished by a candidate is found to be false or fabricated, his/her admission shall be cancelled.
- One set of self-attested photocopies of all the above documents must also be submitted at the time of counselling.
- Candidates are advised to carefully read the GNDU Admission Prospectus 2026-27 for detailed rules, eligibility conditions, and admission guidelines before appearing for counselling.

Note

- Candidates have been called for counselling up to twice the approved intake, as per the provisions of the GNDU Admission Prospectus 2026-27.
- Calling a candidate for counselling does not confer any right to admission. Admission shall be made strictly on the basis of merit, fulfilment of eligibility conditions, reservation policy, verification of original documents, and availability of seats.
- No separate counselling letter will be issued. Candidates are advised to appear for counselling as per the above schedule.
