As per instructions from the Punjab Govt., the counselling for General Category will be held first. The candidates belonging to SC/Backward classes would also compete in the General Category and will be included in the Merit list of the General category. Subsequently, admission for the reserved categories would be made, excluding the reserved category candidates who got admitted in the general category (letter Pb. Govt 7/21/2004 dated 20.12.2004 and letter 517-630/RC dated 16.1.2013, GNDU)

**Counselling Instructions**

- Candidates are requested to bring in person duly filled Counselling Performa given below.**
- Candidates appearing in counselling shall carry with them original DMC's and reserved category certificates for verification. *Mere Receipt from Suvidha Kender as Proof of Applying for a Reserve Category Certificates will not be accepted as a Proof of that Category.*
- Those students, who have passed their lower exam (10+2) through Distance Education Mode, ODL Mode other than PSEB/CBSE/ICSE, will have to check the equivalence of their qualified exams from Equivalence Book ([www.gndu.ac.in](http://www.gndu.ac.in)-University Links/ Information Desk/Registration Branch Desk) or contact to the Equivalence Section of the Registration Branch before applying for admissions to the respective courses.
- Physical presence of the student is mandatory in the Counselling.**
- All the candidates are requested to report on time as per the schedule. If the student has not attend the counseling as per schedule the seat will be allocated to the next candidate
- Each candidate shall bring the following documents at the time of Counselling in

**Original and their self-attested photocopies:**

- Application Form and Admit Card to be printed from “Candidate Login Area/ Dashboard.”
- Matriculation certificate or equivalent examination certificate bearing testimony to date of birth
- +2 DMC/on line self-attested copy of the result of the qualifying examination if DMC has not been issued.
- Character Certificate from the Principal of the college/school last attended (Undertaking that you will provide within 7 Days if not available)
- Migration Certificate (Undertaking that you will provide within 7 Days if not available)
- Two latest pass port size photographs. Photographs must be stapled on the Counselling Form.
- Residence Certificate where ever applicable (As per format in Annexures given in Prospectus 2026)
- Reserved Category Certificate (if Reserved Category claimed). All Reserve Category Certificates should be issued by the competent authority stating that the candidate belongs to that particular reserved category for which he/she is claiming a seat as per format in Annexures given in University Prospectus 2026 available at [www.gnduadmissions.org](http://www.gnduadmissions.org) and Self Declaration as per Annexures I for SC and Annexure II for BC categories.

7. In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the Entrance test, the inter-merit of such candidates shall be determined in order of preference as follows: (a) Candidates obtaining higher marks in the qualifying exam (b) Candidates older in age to be preferred as specified in the prospectus.

**8. The candidate shall have to deposit fee on the spot. The Fee can be deposited through Net Banking, Debit Card, Credit Card, UPI and through Cash and Not by Cheque. Failure to do so will lead to cancellation of Seat.**
