Counselling Schedule for

Bachelor in Nutrition and Dietetics (Honours) Admissions-2026

Venue: Department of Agriculture

All Candidates are required to report at 9:00 AM on 2nd July 2026 in the Department of Agriculture for Counselling for provisional admission to Bachelor in Nutrition and Dietetics (Honours). Rest instructions are given below:

1. **Eligibility for admission shall be as per the provisions of the Guru Nanak Dev University (GNDU) Prospectus 2026-27. As per the GNDU Prospectus, applicants must have passed 10+2 or an equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology with 50% marks and English. Candidates who do not fulfil the prescribed eligibility criteria for admission to the Bachelor of Nutrition and Dietetics (Honours) programme are advised not to attend the counselling session.**
2. The Candidates are required to be present in person for counselling as per schedule.
3. Candidates are requested to bring printed copy of Online **Application Form** (Filled During GNDU Registration) and their original certificates along with the **self-attested photocopies of Matric, +2 DMC, Character Certificate, Migration Certificate, Residence Certificate, Reserved Category Certificate (if Reserved Category claimed), two latest photographs and Income Certificate (if required).**
4. The category claimed at the time of registration, will not be changed at later stage or during counselling process.
5. All admissions made will be provisional. If at any stage, any information furnished by the candidate is found to be fabricated or false, his/her admission will be cancelled.
6. Candidates are required to deposit the requisite admission fee for the selected course as per details mentioned in the GNDU prospectus 2026. The fee can be paid through Net Banking/ Debit Card/Credit Card/ Cash. Otherwise, his/her admission will not be confirmed.
7. The specimen of the residence and other reserved category certificate are available in GNDU prospectus 2026.
