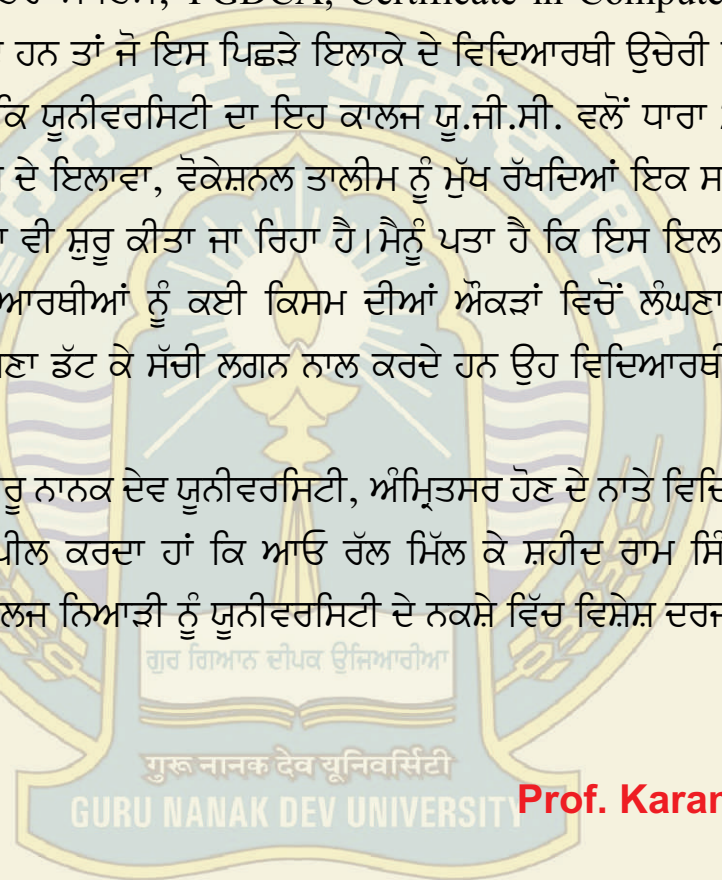

Sci.) and Certificate Course in Computer Application (CCA) degree courses PGDCA offered through regular mode, Guru Nanak Dev University through our illustrious ViceChancellor Prof. (Dr.) Karamjeet Singh has been very kind to establish study centre in respect of Open and Distance Learning Courses in our college. The college also offer Defence and Strategic Studies and Fine Arts also in BA-I and all learning facilities to students of distance education courses in respect of MA in Hindi, Punjabi, Economics, English, Political Science, History, M.Sc.(Computer Science), M.Com and Professional courses such as MBA, MCA. 7 Pb BN NCC Gurdaspur has very kindly allowed an NCC (Army) w.e.f this session. 80 seats have been allotted with the girls and boys in the ratio 40:60. 40 seats (16 for girls and 24 for boys) will be filled in this session and rest 40 in the same ratio will be filled from the next session. COLLEGE HISTORY & PROFILE

Way back in the early nineties, the awakened citizens of Dhar Block, under the patronage of Rajput Sabha joined their heads, hearts and hands together. The noble aim was to provide higher education to the daughters/ sons of the soil i.e the remote and backward areas of Dhar subdivision. It was an uphill task but worth the cause. Drawing inspiration from the great legendary hero of the ilaqa, Shaheed Ram Singh Pathania, they started this educational Institute in the scenic lap of nature at village Niari.

Initial hiccups inspired them to hand-over the college to Guru Nanak Dev University Amritsar, courtesy care and concern of the then education minister Master Mohan Lal ji. The Gram Panchyat of the Naloh/Niari was very kind to offer 27 acres of land for this purpose. Under the stewardship of the worthy Vice-chancellor Dr. H.S Sooch, the Guru Nanak Dev University Amritsar took reins of this College on June 10, 2001. Vide Syndicate decision dated 29-12-2000, the college was taken over by Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, from a private trust and University started imparting instructions in Bachelor of Arts classes. The said decision of the Syndicate was duly approved by the senate of the University vide decision/ resolution dated 25-01-2003. Since then the College is a University College standing as a light house for the Dhar subdivision.

Honorable Vice-chancellor Dr. Jaspal Singh Sandhu is very keen to develop this institution as one of the best educational Colleges. He has been very kind to get the construction of four new classrooms completed and furnished them with sleek furniture.

Located in the lush green edenec surroundings, our College is about 35 kilometers from District Head Quarters on Pathankot-Dalhousie road. The college imparts instructions the following Courses/ Degrees:

- 1) B.A with effect from 2000-2001 & with Comp Sci Subject w.e.f. 2007
- 2) PGDCA with effect from 2008-2009
- 3) BCA with effect from 2010-2011
- 4) B.Com with effect from 2015-16
- 5) B.Sc. Economics with effect from 2012-13
- 6) Diploma in Computer Application with effect from 2012-13
- 7) New subjects : Economics, Mathematics, Sociology w.e.f 2012-13.
- 8) Besides this, we have introduced Semester system from 2012-13 in respect of all First year Courses /degrees.
- 9) From 2017-2018, the college introduced foundation and short term certificate course in Human Rights Education under the aegis of University Grants Commission, New Delhi.
- 10) From 2018-2019 the college started 1 year Diploma Course in Refrigeration and Air Conditioning in Automobiles to promote vocational education.
- 11) From 2018-2019, the University has established a learning support center in respect of various post graduate degree courses like MA in English, Hindi, Punjabi, History, Political Science, M. Sc in Computer Science, M.Com and professional degrees like MBA, and MCA. In addition the learning center will also support students of PG diploma in Computer Application, Diploma in Computer Application, Diploma in Communication Skills and Certificate course in Human Rights and Duties Education.
- 12) From 2019-20 B.Sc.I (Non-Med.), B.Sc.I (Comp. Sc.) and Physical Education in BA.
- 13) Though much has been achieved but greater inputs are required for providing basic infrastructure like Transport, Sports, Technical and Science education.

4-year UG Honours Degree Programmes under NEP 2020 (w.e.f. session 2024-25)

The Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar has introduced 4-year under graduate Honours Degree Programmes as per NEP 2020 in all the affiliated colleges/ constituent colleges from the academic year 2024-25. The University has developed the curricular framework for Honours programmes incorporating a credit-based grading system, a multidisciplinary approach, with specialization in a single discipline specific course in the 4th year of the program.

This policy mandates compliance with the curricular framework and standard operating procedures outlined herein. Compliance with these procedures is mandatory for all the colleges.

The curriculum framework for 4-year UG Degree Programmes has the following features:

1. **Discipline Specific Courses:** Discipline Specific Courses (DSC) are designed to provide in depth knowledge and skills pertinent to a particular field or profession. These courses focus on specialized content and methodologies tailored to the needs of students pursuing carrier in that discipline. These courses are integral to build a solid foundation in the respective fields and often involve both theoretical study and practical application through labs, projects, internship etc.

Each student is required to select and successfully complete three DSCs as part of first 3 years of their undergraduate degree program. In the 4th year of undergraduate honours degree programme, students have the option to choose any one of the Discipline Specific Courses (DSC) that they have studied during the first three years of their undergraduate degree programme.

2. **Ability Enhancement Courses:** Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) are designed to develop essential skills and competencies that complement

the student's major field of study, enhancing their overall educational experience and employability.

Each student is required to successfully complete at least one AEC every year during first three years of undergraduate degree program.

3. **Multidisciplinary Courses:** Multidisciplinary Courses (MDC) are designed to integrate knowledge and methodologies from multiple disciplines, providing student with a holistic understanding of complex issues and fostering innovation thinking.

Each student is required to select and successfully complete at least one MDC every year during first 3 years of undergraduate degree program.

4. **Skill Enhancement Courses:** Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) are designed to develop specific skills that are valuable for personal growth, academic excellence, and carrier readiness.

Each student is required to select and successfully complete at least one SEC every year during first 3 years undergraduate degree program.

5. **Value Added Courses:** Value Added Courses (VAC) are designed to provide students with specialized knowledge and understanding in critical areas that are relevant to societal and environmental challenges.

Value added courses viz Drug Abuse: problem management and prevention, Environmental Studies, and Human Rights & Constitutional Duties are mandatory qualifying courses for a student of an undergraduate degree program. Students is required to successfully complete all the three VACs during first 3 years of undergraduate degree programme.

Standard Operating Procedures

Entry and Exit options for Students of 4-year UG Degree Programme with Honours:

Entry 1: 1st year (1st Sem.):

- The entry requirement for the 1st year of 4-year UG Degree is Intermediate/12th class of PSEB/CBSE/ or any other equivalent certificate and as per the eligibility conditions as specified in the Ordinances related to respective stream/ programme.

Entry 2: 4th year (VIIth Sem.):

- A student who has completed a three-year degree program with three discipline specific subjects (majors) may enter in the 4th year (VIIth Sem) of Honours programme in any one of the three discipline specific subjects (major) studied in the first three years of the UG Degree Programme.

Note: Students who complete the first three years in a college shall be automatically promoted to the 4th year within the same college, without any new admissions provided the student must fulfil all eligibility and promotion criteria as stipulated in CBGS Ordinances.

Exit 1: after 3-years (6 sem.):

- Students must pass all courses/papers in Semesters 1 to 6 if they wish to exit after three years with a normal UG Degree.
- A Bachelor's Degree is to be awarded if students exit after successful completion of 3-year of study.

Exit 2: after 4-years (8 sem.):

- A Bachelor's Degree with Honours is to be awarded if students exit after successful completion of 4-year of study.

Note: Rest of the Ordinances will be as per Credit Based Grading System (CBGS) for Affiliated/Constituent/ University Colleges/Capacity Enhancement Programme/ Private Candidates, and will be in accordance with the University Calendars or as stipulated in the ordinances of the respective stream/ programme unless otherwise specified.

6. If a book is damaged or lost by students, he or she will have to pay twice the price of the book. If the book is part of set of volumes and is not available separately, the price of the whole set will have to be paid.
7. No book will be issued without identity card.
8. Library Books, magazines etc. should not be marked or torn in any way.
9. Necessary rules regarding the library are given in the identity card.
10. Besides the library, separate newspaper reading faculty is available to girls & boys.

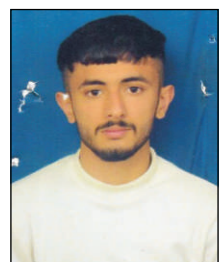
