CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Students are expected to maintain the highest standards of discipline and dignified manner of behaviour inside as well as outside the College campus. They shall abide by the rules and regulations of the College and should act in a way that highlights the discipline and esteem of the College.
2. A six day working schedule from Monday to Saturday is followed at Shaheed Lachhman Singh Dharowali University College Kalanaur.
3. All the students are expected to be present in the class well within time. Late coming will result in loss of attendance for the corresponding quarter of an hour.
4. Students shall rise from their seats when the teacher enters the class room and remain standing till the teacher takes her/his seat or they are allowed by the teacher to sit. Silence shall be observed during class hours.
5. Teachers shall be greeted appropriately with "Good Morning Sir/Miss" or "Good Afternoon Sir/Miss" and a "Thank you Sir/Miss" when the teacher leaves the class room.
6. No student shall enter or leave the class room when the session is on without the permission of the teacher concerned.
7. Students having lab sessions in the FN or AN, have to report to the lab directly in time and they are not expected to go to the class room.
8. In the events of Student seminars/project presentations etc., it is compulsory that all the students of the concerned class be present for the entire session.
9. Students can leave the campus during class hours only after getting a gate pass from the Principal, HOD, or the tutor and after making entry in the Gate Register maintained by the gate keeper.
10. All students shall leave the classes immediately after their last lecture. No students shall wander or gather in verandah, corridor, and staircase etc.
11. All leave applications (Regular & Medical) shall be submitted in time, for sanction by HoD and concerned teachers. Application for medical leave shall be accompanied by valid medical certificates.
12. Students shall come to the college in decent clothes with formal shirts tucked into trousers with black belt and black shoes or semi covered chappals. Hawai type rubber or plastic chappals are not permitted. In addition, lady students will have a dupatta over their shirts.
13. All the students are expected to attend all college functions.
14. All the students shall wear their identity cards, well displayed. Identity badge is a public document and any teaching staff and non-teaching staff shall have the right to peruse it. Denial of that alone invites disciplinary action by the Chief Proctor.
15. All kinds of tattooing, body piercing, hair styling etc. that goes against the existing social norms and which could go against the spirit of academic values will be referred to the discipline committee.
16. As per the Govt. order, students shall not bring modified and powered vehicles inside the campus.
17. Students are expected to maintain silence in the academic buildings to maintain the decorum and, any deviant behavior such as hooting, whistling, loitering etc. will be treated as an instance of indiscipline.
18. For independent study, students are expected to use the class rooms, library or the demarcated areas of the academic building and shall not resort to sitting in staircases or circulation areas.

COLLEGE RULES

It is mandatory for all the students of this college to follow the following rules:

1. Without college Identity Card and, no student will be allowed to enter in the college premises. Students are expected to sit in the classroom before the arrival of teacher.
2. It is prohibited to stand, shout and roam in groups in the corridors.
3. Respect each other at all times. Disagreements will be settled by discussing the problem and seeking a solution that is fair to all concerned.
4. Buildings and the campus will be kept clean.
5. Do not deface or damage college property.
6. All expressions or activities which are immoral, antisocial, communal and anti-national are strictly prohibited in the college campus. Avoid using abusive or profane language and gestures.
7. The college campus is a no smoking/alcohol-free zone.
8. Students are prohibited to use mobile phones within the campus.
9. Photography in the college premises is not allowed.
10. Students found guilty of ragging will be rusticated from the college as per the norms of GNDU.

Rules for House Examination

1. House examinations (MST) will be conducted according to the

guidelines provided by the university and these exams are mandatory for every student.

2. If a student remains absent in house exams without informing the concerned authority, heavy fine will be imposed on him/her
3. If a student will not be able to take house tests due to an unavoidable circumstance, in that case the Principal reserves the right to grant or refuse re- test to him/her.

Rules for University Examination

1. Student must get minimum 35% marks in each subject or aggregate 25% marks in house exams to be eligible for University examinations.
2. Minimum 75% of attendance is mandatory for every student to be eligible to take University exams. Same is applicable for practical subjects also.
3. If a student fails to fulfil the minimum eligibility conditions, he/ she will not be able to claim for University roll number. Such students can be debarred from sitting in the University examinations.

Rules for Leave

1. No Student should be absent without obtaining prior permission from the Principal.
2. No student will be allowed to take leave of more than three



days. In an unavoidable situation, leave must be got sanctioned from the Principal before it is availed of.

3. Application for leave must be signed by the for sick leave of more than three days, the father or the guardian of the applicant. Application should be supported by the medical certificate.
