## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

- A student is required to attend a minimum of 75% of the total lectures conducted in each subject. Attendance for Theory and Practical components shall be calculated separately.
- Furthermore, a student must secure at least 35% aggregate marks in the pre-semester examinations in order to be eligible to appear for the semester examinations.

# LIBRARY AND LEAVE RULES

## Library Rules

- Silence and discipline must be strictly maintained in the library.
- Students must carry a valid ID card while using the library.
- Books must be returned within the prescribed time; a fine will be charged for late returns.
- Reference books, journals, and magazines are for in-library use only.
- Books must be handled with care; in case of loss or damage, replacement or payment is required.
- Eating and drinking are strictly prohibited in the library.

## Leave Rules

- Generally, leave for more than three days will not be granted. For leave exceeding three days, prior permission from the Principal is mandatory.
- The application must be signed by the father or guardian.
- For medical leave exceeding one week, a certificate from a qualified medical officer must be submitted.

3. ਤੀਸਰੇ ਸਮੈਸਟਰ ਤੋਂ ਚੌਥੇ ਸਮੈਸਟਰ ਵਿੱਚ ਜਾਣ ਲਈ ਕੋਈ ਵੀ ਸ਼ਰਤ ਨਹੀਂ ਲਗਾਈ ਗਈ ਹੈ।
4. ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀ ਨੂੰ ਪੰਜਵੇਂ ਸਮੈਸਟਰ ਵਿੱਚ ਤਾਂ ਹੀ ਦਾਖਲਾ ਮਿਲੇਗਾ, ਜੇਕਰ ਉਹ ਪਹਿਲੇ ਚਾਰ ਸਮੈਸਟਰਾਂ ਨੂੰ ਮਿਲਾਕੇ ਬਣਦੇ ਕੁੱਲ ਵਿਸ਼ਿਆਂ ਵਿੱਚੋਂ ਘੱਟੋ-ਘੱਟ 50% ਵਿਸ਼ਿਆਂ ਵਿੱਚੋਂ ਪਾਸ ਹੋਵੇਗਾ।

# CODE OF CONDUCT

# IMPLEMENTATION OF NEP 2020 AT GURU NANAK DEV UNIVERSITY (GNDU)

The major recommendations regarding NEP-2020 are as under :-

Guru Nanak Dev University (GNDU) has proactively embraced the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, initiating several reforms to align with its vision. The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 introduces transformative changes to the higher education system in India. From the academic session 2023-24, our institution will implement the following key recommendations:

## 1. Transition to Four-Year Undergraduate (UG) Honors Degree Programs

Starting from the academic session 2023-24, GNDU has restructured its undergraduate programs into a four-year format

- Completion of Four Years: Award of a Bachelor's Degree with Honors or Research, contingent upon the completion of a research project.

## 2. Introduction of Value-Added Courses (VACs)

To promote holistic education, GNDU has integrated three Value-Added Courses into the curriculum:

- First Year: "Drug Abuse: Problem, Management, and Prevention"
- Second Year: "Environmental Studies"
- Third Year: "Human Rights and Constitutional Duties"

**Completion of each VAC is mandatory during the respective years of the undergraduate program.**

## 3. Language Courses in Professional Programs

In professional programs where English and Punjabi are taught only in the first year (Semesters 1 and 2), this structure remains unchanged. Credits allocated for language courses in subsequent semesters are reallocated to other subjects.

## 4. Ability Enhancement Courses (AECs)

Students are required to complete one Ability Enhancement Course each year during the first three years of their undergraduate program. These courses aim to develop competencies such as communication skills, analytical abilities, and digital literacy.

## 5. Multidisciplinary Courses (MDCs)

To encourage a broad-based education, students must complete one Multidisciplinary Course each year during the first three years. These courses allow exploration of subjects beyond the core discipline, fostering a well-rounded academic experience.

## 6. Skill Enhancement Courses (SECs)

Students are required to complete one Skill Enhancement Course each year during the first three years. SECs are designed to impart practical skills and knowledge, enhancing employability and entrepreneurial capabilities.

## 7. Adoption of Credit-Based Evaluation and Grading System

GNDU has implemented a Credit-Based Evaluation and Grading System to enhance the quality of education and bring transparency to the evaluation process. This system incorporates features such as multidisciplinary courses, ability enhancement courses, value-added courses, training/apprenticeship, and research components. ## 8. Faculty Involvement in Curriculum Redesign

GNDU faculty members have been actively involved in re-designing the curriculum to align with NEP 2020 guidelines. This includes integrating the choice-based credit system, academic bank of credits, and multiple entry and exit systems into the academic calendar.

### **ACTION TO BE TAKEN BY THE HEAD OF THE INSTITUTION : -**

On receipt of the recommendation of the Anti Ragging Squad or on receipt of any information concerning any reported incident of ragging, the Head of Institution shall immediately determine if a case under the penal laws is made and if so, either on his own or through a member of the Anti-Ragging Committee authorized by him in this behalf, proceed to file a First Information Report (FIR), within twenty four hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local authorities, under the appropriate penal provisions relating to one or more.

## **PUNISHMENT FOR PARTICIPATION IN/OR ABETMENT TO RAGGING :**

1. Cancellation of admission.
2. Suspension from attending classes.
3. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
4. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
5. Withholding results.
6. Debarring from representing the institution in any National or International meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
7. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period.
8. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
9. Penalties will be imposed as appropriate.

Our college has taken a proactive step by forming a dedicated committee to address and prevent instances of ragging within our campus community.

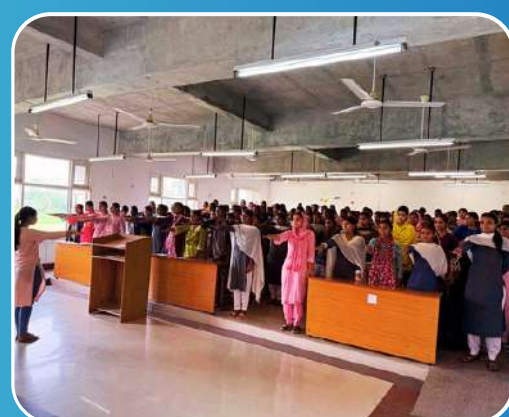
