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GURU NANAK DEV UNIVERSITY



Guru Nanak Dev University was established on November 24, 1969, to mark the birth Quincentenary of Sri Guru Nanak Dev Ji, the founder of Sikhism. The University upholds the teachings and values of the Guru, the apostle of universal brotherhood, truthfulness, non-violence, compassion, tolerance, harmony, humanity, who strictly observed moral and ethical values in daily life.

Ever since its foundation the endeavor of the University has always been to meet the objectives enshrined in the Guru Nanak Dev University Act 1969, which emphasize that the new University would make provisions for imparting education and promoting research in the humanities, learned professions, sciences, especially of applied nature and technology. Hence, it has been promoting education in such fields as Basic and Applied Sciences, Arts, Management, Information Technology, Media, Industrial Technology, Environment, Planning and Architecture Studies. In addition, research on the life and teachings of Guru Nanak Dev ji, promotion of Punjabi language and spreading education among educationally backward classes and communities are its other commitments.

The UGC conferred this University with status of “University with Potential for Excellence” in 2012. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore in December 2022 re-accredited the University in 4th cycle with **CGPA of 3.85 out of 4-pointscale at “A++” grade** highest level, as per accreditation framework of NAAC. Earlier, it had been accredited at “A” grade level in 2000, re-accredited in 2nd cycle 2007 with CGPA of 3.50/4.00 then re-accredited

in 3rd cycle in 2014 with CGPA 3.51/4.00. The current H index of the university is 145 indicating the quality of research publications at national and international level.

Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar has become the only University of Punjab to get the elite "Category-1" status by the University Grants Commission (UGC), giving autonomy to open new Departments, schools, off-campus facilities and start new schools and distance learning programmes, besides the freedom to hire foreign faculty without the UGC's approval.

With the motto of the University as engraved on its emblem 'Guru's wisdom illumines all', the University has been leaving no stone unturned to meet the aspirations and expectations of the society. Spread over area of 500 acres towards the west of the city, Guru Nanak Dev University presents a picture of lush green landscape, modern architecture and sustainable environment. The University today boasts of 45 teaching Departments at the Campus, two regional campuses and 170 affiliated, university and constituent colleges, many of which are located in the rural areas so as to make quality Higher Education accessible to the rural masses. All the programmes of the university compile the guidelines of New Education Policy 2020.

More than twenty thousand students, an overwhelming majority of them being women, are enrolled in various Departments at University Campus, Regional Campuses and University-Constituent Colleges. Online admission, online Counselling, online re-evaluation, introduction of Credit Based Evaluation & Grading System etc. are a few hallmarks of the University. All the results have been computerized and OMR (Optical Magnetic Recognition) system is being used to bring in more efficiency and transparency. It is the first University in the region to have computerized its examination and registration system. The students now have an all-time access to their results through SMS service.

Academically also, the University has carved a niche for itself in the field of Higher Education in the country. Our university is recognized as one of the leading institutions in North India in the domain of Arts, Humanities, Science and Technology. Many coveted projects from the apex bodies like MHRD, DST, CSIR, BARC and other organizations worth crores of rupees have been awarded to our faculty members. One of the four Nodal Calibration Centres established by Bhabha Atomic Research Centre is set up at our campus. The Centre of Emerging Life Sciences equipped with the state-of-the-art scientific instrument's worth crores of rupees, a well-maintained Botanical Garden, Department of Sports Medicine & Physiotherapy are a few to mention. A well-equipped modern computer lab with the help of TCS has been established to strengthen the University infrastructure and to prepare students for employment. Presently, a Centre with Potential for Excellence in Life Sciences and a Centre for Advanced Study in Chemistry granted

by UGC are working successfully in the University. A Centre for Entrepreneurship and Innovation is being set up in the university under the aegis of *Rashtriya Uchatar Shiksha Abhiyan* to provide skill-oriented training and incubation facilities.

The fact that the University has been the winner of the coveted Maulana Abdul Kalam Azad Trophy, the highest Sports award for a University in the country, for a record number of 25 times, speaks volumes about its supremacy in the field of Sports. An Astro Turf for hockey, a swimming pool of International Standards, a velodrome, a gymnasium hall, a shooting range and many other state-of-the art Sports facilities are the prized possessions of the University. The Lifelong Learning Department of the University is successfully catering to the male and female folk of the region to make them self-dependent by offering various skill development programmes.

The track record of employment of our students by big business houses and multinational companies has been very satisfactory. Our students of engineering, planning, architecture, management and commerce field are employed by government sector and companies in India and abroad. They are all contributing to the credit worthiness of the University by their hard work and diligence. All these achievements and successes are due to the heart and soul put in by the students, faculty members, and administration of the University.

Being at the forefront of innovation, invention and novelty, a home to transformational research and enthused learning, the University has also earned “Category One” status and has become the only University to receive this elite status in the region of Punjab and Chandigarh. With the forte to persistently endeavour to become better and the undying zeal to achieve majestic acmes, the University has created a niche for itself at the global level and as a result, MHRD, Government of India has recognized our University as one of the top ten “High Performing State Public Universities” across India. For sweating to reduce its carbon footprint and maintain cleanliness on campus, Guru Nanak Dev University has been ranked second amongst the cleanest higher educational institutions in the country in the category of Government Universities by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.



As Guru Nanak Dev University is committed to advancing academic excellence, expanding liberal and professional knowledge and creating a diverse and inclusive community, our NIRF Rank has risen from 80th in 2017 to 48th in 2023. In the World Universities Ranking (CWUR) our University is placed amongst the top 23% of the universities. We have also won the highest sports award in the country, the Maulana Abul Kalam Azad Trophy, for a record of 25 times. It has been awarded “One District One Green Champion” by Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education (MGNCRE), Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Government of India. The University had been the winner of both North Zone and National Inter-University Youth Festivals in 2017-18 and was runner up for the same in 2018-19 and 2022-23. More than twenty departments of the University have received varied grants under UGC-SAP, DST-FIST, and PURSE, in addition to the individual grants received by the faculty. The University has received substantial funding for establishing Centre for Interfaith Studies and MYAS-GNDU Centre for Sports Sciences besides RUSA & other grants. Two Academies for Fencing and Archery have been allocated to Guru Nanak Dev University under “Khelo India” scheme of the Government of India. Additionally, two Centres for Handball and Hockey have also been allocated to GNDU under the same scheme. Government of India has allotted us four Centres of Excellence in Sports (Athletics, Fencing, Cycling & Swimming) and sanctioned a grant of Rs 17 Crores.

Through a wide array of extracurricular activities, community engagement initiatives, and leadership development programs, we nurture well-rounded individuals who are not only academically proficient but also socially responsible and ethically grounded. Our commitment to student support services, mentorship programs, and experiential learning opportunities has helped to cultivate the next generation of leaders, scholars, and global citizens. An amphitheatre named ‘Golden Expressions’ has been constructed to provide a platform to all the students to express

themselves. More than 80% students have been placed successfully by 92 various Multi-National Companies. Furthermore, our university boasts state-of-the-art infrastructure, including modern classrooms, well-equipped laboratories, cutting-edge research facilities, libraries, sports complexes and hostels. Our lush green campus provides an ideal environment for learning, collaboration, and personal growth, fostering a sense of community and belonging among our students, faculty, and staff.

The Golden Jubilee Centre for Entrepreneurship and Innovation (GJCEI), established at Guru Nanak Dev University as part of RUSA 2.0's Component-4, actively fosters entrepreneurship and innovation to drive economic growth. It boasts a cutting-edge infrastructure currently accommodating nineteen start-ups and overseeing seven innovation-driven projects worth ₹68.91 lakhs. Additionally, within the university, the Centre for Agricultural Research and Innovation (CARI) has been established, aiming to integrate research and education in agriculture, food systems, and the environment. Notably, CARI focuses on cultivating high-value, non-traditional crops like low-chilled apples, bananas, saffron, and elite sweet potato varieties enriched with beta-carotene and anthocyanin.

With a vision to shape the future of our learners, Guru Nanak Dev University is building a sturdy network of global partnerships by fashioning bridges with industries, institutions and communities. The university has also taken initiatives to make many of its processes digitalized. Our Credit Based Evaluation System and a well-developed Placement Cell assure the continuity of learning process and employment security to our students. In order to prepare the students for a highly networked and competitive world, the University supports their interests, emboldens them to develop individual perspectives, and instills managerial and administrative skills in them. Since we attempt to transform our industrious students into smart team players, ethical leaders and conscientious citizens, Guru Nanak Dev University has witnessed a substantial increase of 40% admissions from the last four years, despite an overall fall in admissions in the State.

Moreover, admirable architecture, up-to-the-minute substructure in well-equipped laboratories, modern-day studios/classrooms for research and teaching, Guru Nanak Dev University is known to provide a conducive ambience for work which has helped many members of faculty and researchers win esteemed national and international recognitions and major research projects from the UGC. The provision of interdisciplinary relationship between science and literature, economics and environment, social sciences and linguistics, physiotherapy and psychology has brought Governmental recognition to members of our faculty. Many members of the University are serving the Government of India in the highest capacities. It is a matter of pride that the h-index of the University has increased to 145. Guru Nanak Dev University is a beacon of light in the field of education standing tall year after year with its worthy credentials and successful achievements and it will continue to excel with its forward-looking approach.

It is noteworthy that our students have won 3 medals at Shooting World Cup 2022 at Changwon, KOREA.

College Profile

Guru Nanak Dev University College, Jalandhar which was started as Punjab University College in 1962, came under the jurisdiction of the Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar in 1973. Located in the center of the city, it is situated at a distance of just 1 km from the railway station and 2 km from the bus stand. With traditional and novel educational programs and requisite infrastructure, the college is housed in a majestic building and has a peaceful, natural and conducive environment for studies.

It was started as an arts College, gradually shifted its focus from the traditional to the professional courses. With the prime objective to provide quality education and career opportunities to students of the region and make them employable keeping in view of the changing market needs MCA(FYIC) was started in the year 2002, MBA(FYIC) IN 2004, MBA (Two years) in 2010 and MCA (Two years) in the academic session 2011-2012. In continuation with these endeavors, B. Com, B. Com (Honors) & BCOM (Financial Services) and M. Com courses were started from the academic session 2013-14. Besides, BBA, BCA and were also started from academic year 2014-15. These professional courses will create young leaders, winners and achievers in a global corporate world.

The college claims excellent infrastructure in terms of airy class rooms, modern computer labs, and well-equipped seminar halls which are aesthetically designed to ensure high degree efficiency in the teaching learning process. Wi-Fi facility, 2 Mbps leased line; modern teaching aids like multi-media projectors are available to complement the teaching learning process.

The college is presently also offering 7 programs as a learning center under the Directorate of Open and Distance Learning of Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar. The courses offered included 4 post graduate degrees (MBA, MCA, M.COM , MA Punjabi), 3 undergraduate degree course (MBA FYIP, BCOM, BCA) and 2 vocational course B.Voc (Ecommerce & Digital Marketing), B.Voc (Journalism and Media). The college always strives to provide excellent quality education with its expert faculty and supportive infrastructure.

4-YEAR UG HONOURS DEGREE PROGRAMMES UNDER NEP 2020

(w.e.f. session 2024-25)

The Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar has introduced 4-year undergraduate Honours Degree Programmes as per NEP 2020 in all the affiliated colleges/constituent colleges from the academic year 2024-25. The University has developed the curricular framework for Honors programmes incorporating a credit-based grading System, a multidisciplinary approach with specialization in a single discipline specific course in the 4th year of the program.

This policy mandates compliance with the curricular framework and standard operating procedures outlined herein. Compliance with these procedures is mandatory for all the colleges.

The curriculum framework for 4-year UG Degree Programmes has the following features:

1. **Discipline Specific Courses:** Discipline Specific Course (DSC) are designed to provide in depth knowledge and skill pertinent to a particular field or profession. These courses focus on specialized content and methodologies tailored to the needs of students pursuing a career in that discipline. These courses are integral to build a solid foundation in the respective fields and often involve both theoretical study and practical application through labs, project, internship etc.

Each student is required to select and successfully complete three DSCs as part of first 3 years of their undergraduate degree program, in the 4th year of the undergraduate honours degree programme, students have the option to choose any one of the Discipline Specifics Course (DSC) that they have studied during the first three years of their undergraduate degree programme.

2. **Ability Enhancement Course:** Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) Are assigned to develop essential skills and competencies that complement the students' major field of study, enhancing their overall educational experience and employability.

Each student is required to successfully complete at least one AEC every year during first three years of undergraduate degree program.

3. **Multidisciplinary Course:** Multidisciplinary Course (MDC) are designed to develop specific skill that are valuable for personal growth, academic excellence and career readiness.

Each student is required to select and successfully complete at least one MDC every year during first 3 years undergraduate degree program.

4. **Skill Enhancement Courses:** Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) are assigned to develop specific skills that are valuable for personal growth, academic excellence, and carrier readiness.

Each student is required to select and successfully complete at least one SEC every year during first 3 years undergraduate degree program.

5. **Value Added Courses:** Value Added Courses (VAC) are designed to provide students with specialized knowledge and understanding in critical that are relevant to societal environmental challenges.

Value Added Courses viz Drug Abuse: problem management and prevention, Environmental Studies, and Human Rights & Constitutional Duties are mandatory qualifying courses for students of an undergraduate degree program. Students are required to successfully complete all three VACs during the first 3 years of undergraduate degree programme.

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES

Entry and Exit options for students of 4-Year

UG degree Programme with Honours

- **Entry 1: 1st year (1st Sem)**

The entry requirement for the 1st year of 4-year UG Degree is Intermediate/12m class of PSEB/CBSE or any other equivalent certificate and as per the eligibility as specified in the Ordinances related to respective stream /programme.

- **Entry 2: 4th year (7th Sem)**

A student who has completed a three-year degree program with three discipline specific subjects (majors) may enter in the 4th year (VII Sem) of Honors programme in any one of the three discipline specific subjects (major) studied in the first three years of the UG Degree Programme.

Note: Students who complete the first three years in a college shall be automatically promoted to the 4th year within the same college without any new admissions provided the student must fulfil all eligibility and promotion criteria as stipulated in CBGS Ordinances.

- **Exit 1: after 3 years (6th Sem)**

Students must pass all courses/papers in Semesters 1 to 6 if they wish to exit after three years with a normal UG Degree.

A bachelor's degree is to be awarded if a student exits, after successful completion of 3 years of study.

- **Exit 2: after 4 years (8th Sem)**

A bachelor's degree with honors is to be awarded if student exits after successful completion of 4 years of study

Note: Rest of the ordinances will be as per Credit Based Grading System (CBGS) for Affiliated/Constituent/University Colleges/Capacity Enhancement Programme/Private Candidates and will be in accordance with the University Calendars or as stipulated in the ordinances of the respective stream/programme unless otherwise specified.

LEARNING OUTPUTS AND COMPETENCIES

- **Department of Management**

Management department conducts professional courses like BBA and MBA in Two years as well as Five years stream. MBA courses are CREDIT BASED CHOICE SYSTEM pliant. Successful candidates pass out with allocation of grades which is in sync with global level practices. Pedagogy includes all modern teaching tools. Visits of key managerial personnel from renowned industry to interact UBS students in campus are regular exercise to explore Industry-Academia linkages. Internship with industry after 2nd semester in Two years course and after 4th semester and again after 8th semester in Five years course is with a view to enabling management students to have requisite exposure of ongoing business management world challenges. Candidates pursuing MBA in two as well as five years stream are groomed to join globalarmy of managerial personnel. 60 seats are allocated to MBA (TYC) and MBA (FYIC) in each stream.

- **Department of Commerce**

Commerce department's main focus is on practical knowledge besides theoretical inputs. Pedagogy involves discussions & effort is to make students understand rather than cramming the things. The courses offered by the department are: B. Com, B.Com (Hons), B. Com (Financial Services) & M.Com. Commerce graduates can pursue further studies like doing M.Com, MBA, CA, CS, and LLB in any subject. They can seek jobs in sectors like banking, insurance, Finance, marketing, education etc. and, can also appear in competitive exams. M.Com degree holders can make their careers in teaching, banking, insurance, accounting, auditing, Finance, marketing, stock broking companies etc., both in the government & the private sectors. Commerce graduates & postgraduates are always better prepared to do their own business also.

- **Department of Computer Science**

The digital information age has established itself in all areas over the past various years. MCA & BCA are designed for learners who desire to gain greater competency in the use of specific computing applications. It is a priority in MCA to enable students acquires professional knowledge while learning and working with cutting edge technologies. Onsuccessful completion of this course, pass outs will be able to develop proficiency in the usage of a variety of computer hardware and software tools, develop skills in using computer and related digital technology to solve various problems. MCA makes its students competent enough to apply acquired knowledge in migrating to new and emerging standards and technologies.

RAGGING IN ANY FORM OR MANNER IS STRICTLY BANNED IN COLLEGE

RAGGING MENACE

Ragging is a disturbing reality in the higher education system of our country. Despite the fact that over the years, ragging has claimed hundreds of innocent lives and has ruined the careers of thousands of bright students, the practice is still perceived by many as a way of ‘familiarisation’ and an ‘initiation into the real world’ for young college-going students. Ragging is defined as any disorderly conduct, whether by words spoken or written or by an act, has the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness a fresher or a junior student. Indulging in a rowdy or undisciplined activity that causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or junior student. Asking the students to do any act or perform something that such students will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or junior student. This can lead to adverse effects such as depression, anxiety, and sometimes even suicide. Punishment Provisions Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging on campus or off campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments:

- Debarring from appearing in any sessional test/university examination or withholding results.
- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits.
- Suspension from the college for a period of one month.
- Cancellation of admission.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent periods.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
- Fine up to twenty-five thousand rupees.
- Imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years or with fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees or with both.
- Collective punishment – When the students committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers. Any institution that fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or fails to act in accordance with the Regulations or fails to punish perpetrators or incidents of ragging

suitably is liable to the penalties and punishments as per the provisions of the Regulations.
