CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Students are expected to maintain the highest standard of discipline and a dignified manner of behaviour inside as well as outside the college campus. They shall abide by the rules and regulations of the college and act in a way that upholds the discipline and esteem of the college.
- 2. Our six day working schedule, from Monday to Saturday, is followed at Shaheed Lachhman Singh Dharowali University College Kalanaur.
- 3. All students are expected to be present in class well within time; late coming will result in a loss of attendance for the corresponding quarter of an hour.
- 4. Students shall rise from their seats when the teacher enters the classroom and remain standing until the teacher takes her/his seat or they are allowed by the teacher to sit. Silence shall be observed during class hours.
- 5. Teachers shall be greeted appropriately with "Good morning Sir/Madam" or "Good afternoon Sir/Madam" and thanked with " Thank you, Sir/Madam" when the teacher leaves the classroom.
- 6. No student shall enter or leave the classroom when the session is in progress without the permission of the teacher concerned.
- 7. Students having lab sessions in the morning or afternoon, have to report directly to the lab on time and are not expected to go to the classroom.
- 8. In the event of student seminars/project presentations etc., it is compulsory that all students of the concerned class be present for the entire session.
- 9. Students can leave the campus during class hours only after obtaining a gate pass from the Principal, HOD, or the tutor, and after making an entry in the gate register maintained by the gatekeeper.

- 10. All students shall leave the classes immediately after their last lecture. No students shall doiter or gather in the veranda, corridors, staircases, etc.
- 11. All leave applications (Regular & Medical) shall be submitted in a timely manner, for sanction by HOD and concerned teachers. Applications for medical leave shall be accompanied by valid medical certificates.
- 12. Students shall come to college in decent clothes, with formal shirts tucked into trousers, accompanied by a black belt and black shoes or semi-covered chappels. Hawai type rubber or plastic chappals are not permitted. In addition, lady students will wear a dupatta over their shirts.
 - 13. All students are expected to attend all college functions.
 - 14. All students shall wear their identity cards in a clearly visible manner. The identity badge is a public document, and any teaching or non-teaching staff members shall have the right to peruse it. Denial of access to it alone may invite disciplinary action.
 - 15. All kinds of tattooing, body piercing, hair styling etc. that contravene existing social norms and potentially undermine the spirit of academic values will be referred to the discipline committee.
 - 16. As per the government order, students shall not bring modified or powered vehicles inside the campus.
 - 17. Students are expected to maintain silence in the academic buildings. Any deviant behaviour, such as hooting, whistling, loitering etc, will be treated as an instance of indiscipline.
 - 18. For independent study, students are expected to use the classrooms, library, or designated areas of the building and shall not occupy staircases or circulation areas, as this could interfere with free movement.

COLLEGE RULES

It is mandatory for all the students of this college to follow the following rules:

- Without college Identity Card and, no student will be allowed to enter in the college premises Students are expected to sit in the classroom before the arrival of teacher.
- 2. It is prohibited to stand, shout and roam in groups in the corridors.
- Respect each other at all times
 Disagreements will be settled by

 seeking a solution that is fair to
 all concerned.
- 4. Buildings and the campus will be kept clean.
- 5. Do not deface or damage college property.
- 6. All expressions or activities which are immoral, antisocial, communal and anti-national are strictly prohibited in the college campus. Avoid using abusive or profane language and gestures.
- 7. The college campus is a no smoking/alcohol-free zone.
- 8. Students are prohibited to use mobile phones within the campus.
- 9. Photography in the college premises is not allowed.
- Students found guilty of ragging will be rusticated from the college as per the norms of GNDU.

Rules for House Examination

 House examinations (MST) will be conducted according to the guidelines provided by the university and these exams are mandatory for every student.

- 2. If a student remains absent in house exams without informing the concerned authority, heavy fine will be imposed on him/her
- 3. If a student will not be able to take house tests due to an unavoidable circumstance, in that case the Principal reserves the right to grant or refuse re- test to him/her.

Rules for University Examination

- Student must get minimum 35% marks in each subject or aggregate 25% marks in house exams to be eligible for University examinations.
- Minimum 75% of attendance is mandatory for every student to be eligible to take University

exams. Same is applicable for practical subjects also.

3. If a student fails to fulfil the minimum eligibility conditions, he/ she will not be able to claim far University roll number. Such students can be debarred from sitting in the University examinations.

Rules for Leave

 No Student should be absent without obtaining prior

- permission from the Principal.
- 2. No student will be allowed to take leave of more than three days. In an unavoidable situation, leave must be got sanctioned from the Principal before it is availed of.
- 3. Application for leave must be signed by the for sick leave of more than three days, the father or the guardian of the applicant. Application should be supported by the medical certificate.
