

# RAGGING IN ANY FORM OR MANNER IS STRICTLY BANNED IN THE COLLEGE

## UGC REGULATIONS ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS, 2009

(Under Section 26(1) (g) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956) New Delhi-110002, the 17th June 2009

WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING: Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- a) Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- b) Indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- c) Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- d) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- e) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- f) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students
- g) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- h) Any act or abuse by spoken words, e-mails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- i) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure of showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

**ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING:** The institution shall punish a student found guilty of ragging after following the procedure and in the manner prescribed here in under:

- ❖ The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, in regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad.
- ❖ The Anti-Ragging Committee may depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad award to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely:
- a) Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- b) Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- c) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- d) Withholding results.
- e) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- f) Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- g) Cancellation of admission.
- h) Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- i) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
- ❖ Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.
- ❖ An appeal against the order of punishment by the Anti-Ragging Committee shall lie, (i) in case of an order of an institution, affiliated to or constituent part, of a University, to the Vice-Chancellor of the University; (ii) in case of an order of a University, to its Chancellor. (iii) in case of an institution of national importance created by an Act of Parliament, to the Chairman or Chancellor of the institution, as the case may be.

#### **ADMISSION RULES**

## Following Certificates/documents are required to be produced at the time of admission:

- Original certificate of having passed the lower examination.
- Candidates who have already registered with the University will produce his/her Registration Card at the time of admission.
- Candidates belonging to SC/ST/Backward class are required to attach a certificate for the same with the admission form attested by the following authorities –(a) Magistrate First Class or (b) Tehsildar
- Foreign students are required to attach Eligibility Certificate with the admission form, otherwise they will not be considered for the admission.
- Candidates from other Universities are required to produce Migration Certificate. They are also required to produce a certificate of good moral character.
- Students are required to deposit tuition fee and other funds in June and December.
- Character certificate from the head of the institute last attended.
- Original certificate from Board/University which shows Date of Birth of the candidate.
- Students seeking admission after a gap will produce document mentioning reason of gap. Admission authority may refuse admission to such students keeping in view academic and administrative reasons.

Note: The Principal/Incharge reserves the right to grant or refuse admission to any candidate without assigning any reason.

#### LIBRARY RULES

- i. A student can get only two books at one time.
- ii. The issued books must be returned within 15 days. Students who fail to return the books on the due date shall pay a fine of Re 1/- per day, per book for the period beyond that date.
- iii. If needed, librarian can ask the student to return the issued books immediately.
- iv. Students are not allowed to pass the books to any other person.
- v. Reference books and Periodicals shall not be issued.
- vi. If a student loses or damages a book, he/she will have to submit a new copy or pay its cost.

- vii. Students are advised to check the books when these are issued. If a book is found torn or damaged on its return, the student will be held responsible for it.
- viii. Every student is given tickets along with the identity card. The books shall be issued only on the presentation of the ticket. In case of loss of the ticket, a duplicate ticket may be issued on the payment of Rs 10/- per ticket.
  - ix. It is compulsory for a student to deposit the ticket and identity card before leaving the college.
  - x. The students must observe silence in the library.
  - xi. In case of loss of Identity card, a duplicate Identity card may be issued on the payment of Rs. 25/- per Identity card.

#### ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE RULES

- i. Student coming late in the class will not be marked present. However, she/he may be permitted to attend the lecture.
- ii. Student must apply for leave on the leave form available in the College Office.
- iii. In case of severe illness, the student should apply for leave as early as he/she comes to the College. Medical Certificate must be attached with the application form. Leave for whatever reason will not benefit the student to complete his/her lectures.
- iv. Application for leave must be signed by father or guardian.
- v. Only the Principal can recommend the leave in-charge. Leave for more than three days will be sanctioned by the Principal on the recommendation of the teacher-in-charge.
- vi. Leave for one period can be granted by the concerned teacher.
- vii. Fine for absence will be charged.

Note: It is student's own responsibility to enquire about his/her lectures at the end of every month from the concerned teachers. Every student will fulfill the condition of prescribed lectures to sit in examination.

#### 4-YEAR UG HONOURS DEGREE PROGRAMMES UNDER NEP 2020

#### (WEF session 2025-26)

The Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar has introduced 4-year under graduate Honours Degree Programmes as per NEP 2020 in all the affiliated colleges/ constituent colleges from the academic year 2024-25. The University has developed the curricular framework for Honours programmes incorporating a credit-based grading system, a multidisciplinary approach, with specialization in a single discipline specific course in the 4th year of the program.

This policy mandates compliance with the curricular framework and standard operating procedures outlined herein. Compliance with these procedures is mandatory for all the colleges.

The curriculum framework for 4-year UG Degree Programmes has the following features:

- 1. Discipline Specific Courses: Discipline Specific Courses (DSC) are designed to provide in depth knowledge and skills pertinent to a particular field or profession. These courses focus on specialized content and methodologies tailored to the needs of students pursuing carrier in that discipline. These courses are integral to build a solid foundation in the respective fields and often involve both theoretical study and practical application through labs, projects, internship etc. Each student is required to select and successfully complete three DSCs as part of first 3 years of their undergraduate degree program, in the 4th year of undergraduate honours degree programme, students have the option to choose any one of the Discipline Specific Courses (DSC) that they have studied during the first three years of their undergraduate degree programme.
- 2. Ability Enhancement Courses: Ability Enhancement Courses (ABC) are designed to develop essential skills and competencies that complement the student's major field of study, enhancing their overall educational experience and employability. Each student is required to successfully complete at least one ABC every year during first three years of undergraduate degree program.
- 3. Multidisciplinary Courses: Multidisciplinary Courses (MDC) are designed to integrate knowledge and methodologies from multiple disciplines, providing student with a holistic understanding of complex issues and fostering innovation thinking. Each student is required to select and successfully complete at least one MDC every year during first 3 years of undergraduate degree program.
- 4. **Skill Enhancement Courses:** Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) are designed to develop specific skills that are valuable for personal growth, academic excellence, and carrier readiness. Each student is required to select and successfully complete at least one SEC every year during first 3 years undergraduate degree program.
- 5. Value Added Courses: Value Added Courses (VAC) are designed to provide students with specialized knowledge and understanding in critical areas that are relevant to societal and environmental

  Value added courses viz. Drug Abuse: problem management and prevention, Environmental Studies, and Human Rights & Constitutional Duties are mandatory qualifying courses for a student of an undergraduate degree program. A Student is required to successfully complete all the three VACs during first 3 years of undergraduate degree programme.

# Standard Operating Procedures Entry and Exit options for Students of 4-Year UG Degree Programme with Honours:

#### Entry 1: 1st year (1st Sem.):

The entry requirement for the 1 year of 4-year UG Degree is Intermediate/ 12m class of PSEB/CBSE/ or any other equivalent certificate and as per the eligibility conditions as specified in the Ordinances related to respective stream/ programme.

#### Entry 2: 4th year (VII Sem.):

A student who has completed a three-year degree program with three discipline specific subjects (majors) may enter in the 4th year (VII\*Sem) of Honours programme in any one of the three discipline specific subjects (major) studied in the first three years of the UG Degree Programme.

Note: Students who complete the first three years in a college shall be automatically promoted to the 4th year within the same college, without any new admissions provided the student must fulfil all eligibility and promotion criteria as stipulated in CBGS Ordinances.

#### Exit 1: after 3-years (VI Sem.):

Students must pass all courses/ papers in Semesters 1 to 6 if they wish to exit after three years with a normal UG Degree.

A Bachelor's Degree is to be awarded if students exit after successful completion of 3-year of study.

#### Exit 2: after 4-years (VIII Sem.):

A Bachelor's Degree with Honours is to be awarded if students exit after successful completion of 4 year of study.

Note: Rest of the Ordinances will be as per Credit Based Grading System (CBGS) for Affiliated /constituent/University Colleges/Capacity Enhancement Programme/ Private Candidates, and will be in the accordance with the University Calendars or as stipulated in the ordinances of the respective stream/programme unless otherwise specified.
